
CODES OF CONDUCT

- **Conserve Forest**

- Make no open fires & educate & discourage others from doing so
- Use kerosene instead of firewood for cooking & heating
- While staying in lodges, discourage use of fuel wood, use iodine or a water purifier instead of asking for boiled water, as this will cut down on the amount of wood used
- Do not pick any flowers or medicinal plants
- Do not take cuttings, seeds & roots of the plants

- **Conserve Wildlife**

- Do not disturb & hurt wildlife or its habitat
- Do not buy & sell parts of endangered animals

- **Conserve Cultural Heritage**

- Do not buy or sell antique cultural artefacts
- Respect holy places & do not remove religious objects
- Respect local traditions and cultures

- **Respect People**

- When taking photographs, respect privacy & ask permission first
- Respect local modesty. Do not wear revealing clothes & do not kiss in the public
- Do not encourage begging. Make a donation to a project, health centre or school instead

- **Do not Pollute**

- Burn or bury paper and carry out all non-degradable litter such as Plastics, Glasses & Tin
- Keep local water clean. Do not use pollutant such as detergents in the streams or the springs and do not wash clothes in the stream directly
- If toilet facilities are not available, make sure you are at least 50m away from water sources & bury or cover waste
- Camp only in the designated areas. Leave it cleaner than you found it
